Updated CDC Guidelines for Those Fully Vaccinated

Earlier this week we sent a message about the CDC's updated guidance for those who are fully vaccinated when at home and in public spaces. We want to remind you that this guidance specifically called out healthcare workers and healthcare facilities as an exception to these changes.

Masking, social distancing, and handwashing are all still in place in all Northern Light Health facilities for staff and patients, regardless of vaccination status to help us protect our patients and vulnerable communities.

Updated Travel Guidelines Clarification/Reminder

Last week the state of Maine updated travel guidelines, relaxing the need for testing and reducing the time required for isolation for many states. Please note that not all of these changes apply to all locations, and that healthcare workers in patient facing roles are required to isolate for 14 days after international travel, regardless of COVID-19 test results.

COVID-19 Vaccination Update

School Employees and Childcare Providers:

Northern Light Health is starting to offer COVID-19 vaccine to school employees and licensed childcare providers. This plan is based on the state's current vaccination plan and guidance.

We are excited to work together with our colleagues at local retail pharmacies to offer vaccinations to educators, we are all in this together to ensure the health and safety of our communities. If community members in this group are unable to book an appointment with us, please do not hesitate to refer them to their local Walgreens, Hannaford, Wal-Mart, or Sam's Club, who have dedicated their full supply of vaccine to this group.

Currently:

- The State of Maine and the Department of Education has asked to reserve a certain number of vaccines for school staff who are 60+. This link is being share directly by the Department of Education to school administrators to share with staff.
- General registration has opened for school staff and licensed childcare providers of any age on our website using the general scheduling tool, this option is visible as people move through the registration process.

Important information for this vaccination group: They MUST bring identification documenting workplace in the current eligible category, such as a pay stub, work ID, or copy of their license/certification.
